QUESTION 2 PARAGRAPH: PERSONAL RESPONSE

Study the extract below before answering the question that follows.

President de Gaulle started by inquiring as to Madame Ambassador's professional background. Amanda Einstein said that really she was rather a blockhead, that she had bribed her way to the position of governor of Bali and then bribed her way to re-election in two subsequent elections, that she had made pots of money for herself and her extended family for many years until the new President Suharto had, quite out of the blue, phoned and offered her the position of ambassador in Paris.

Do you think that the author of the novel succeeds in exposing how **bribery** and **corruption** have infiltrated our society and governing systems on almost all levels?

In a paragraph of about **180 words**, share your thoughts on the above question. Base your response on Amanda Einstein, the country Indonesia and the island Bali.

Remember:

- The tone of your paragraph should be persuasive.
- Although your answer must be a personal opinion, you have to clearly justify your point of view with references from the novel.
- Provide an accurate word count at the end of your paragraph.

Content – relevant content, well-reasoned statements and examples from the novel.	10 marks
Language, style and register are appropriate; clear stance and overall convincing voice.	5 marks

QUESTION 3 DIALOGUE

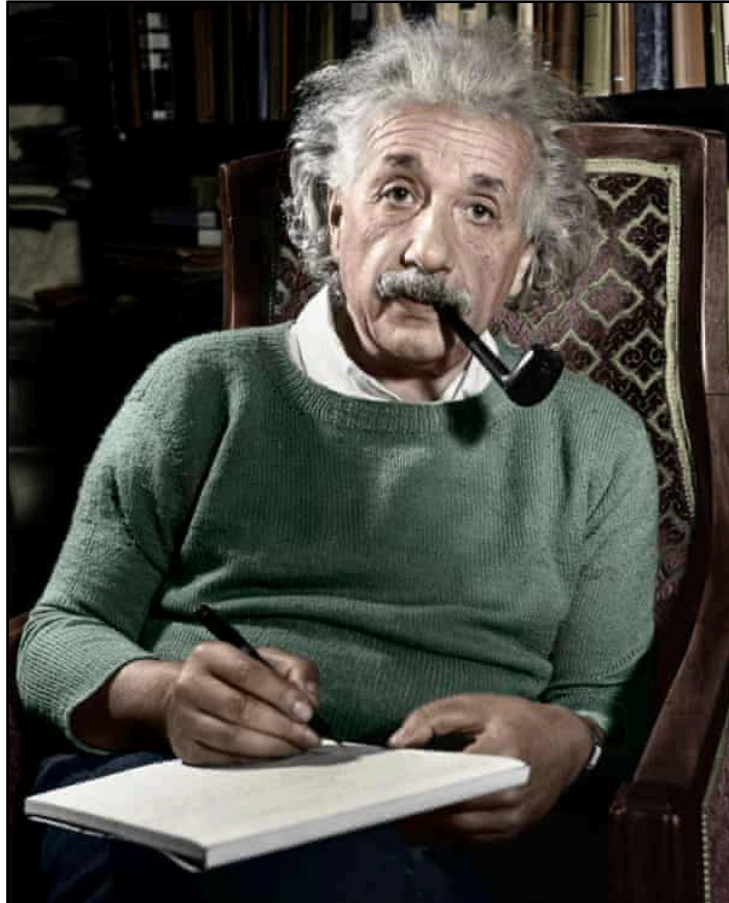
Imagine that you are Albert Einstein, Herbert Einstein's half-brother. You are attending Herbert's funeral where you have just met Allan Karlsson. You are curious to learn more about the brother you never really knew.

In a dialogue of about **180 words** (content only), write down the conversation between you and Allan in **which you talk about the friendship between Allan and Herbert and what happened in Vladivostok.**

Remember:

- Your writing should demonstrate that you understand the relationship between Allan and Herbert, that you know the facts of the novel and that you can use this information in a new and original way.
- Make sure you use the correct style and format, including meaningful gestures in the present tense to make your dialogue come alive.
- Provide an accurate word count.

Content – a mark out of 7 for relevant and creative content linked to the question.	7 marks
Dialogue format, occasional, meaningful gesture in present tense and conversational style.	3 marks

QUESTION 4 ESSAY WITH GUIDELINES

Study the extract from the novel, as well as the comment below, before answering the question.

**CENTENARIAN KIDNAPPED
BY CRIMINAL GANG.
HUNT ON TODAY FOR NOTORIOUS
MASTER THIEF – POLICE**

[Extract from *The Hundred-Year-Old Man Who
Climbed out of the Window and Disappeared*,
Chapter 8]

Do not judge a person by his/her appearance.

Allan Karlsson is 100 years old and is therefore often assumed to be harmless, clueless and the victim of criminals. But looks can be deceiving: he instigates several criminal acts such as theft, murder and bribery.

Write an essay of about **250 words** in which you discuss how Allan's appearance deceives Inspector Aronsson, Bolt and Bucket.

Use the following guidelines to assist you:

Paragraph 1: Use the stimuli to introduce the topic.

Paragraph 2: Discuss the assumptions of Inspector Aronsson, regarding Allan Karlsson's involvement in the investigation.

Paragraph 3: Discuss how Bolt misjudged Allan.

Paragraph 4: Discuss how Bucket misjudged Allan.

Paragraph 5: Draw the different aspects of the essay together and provide a general conclusion related to the topic.

Please make sure that you:

- Provide a suitable title for your essay.
- Use the stimuli (topic) and guidelines provided above.
- Use relevant facts from and references to the novel to support your viewpoint.
- Use clear, logically linked paragraphs, i.e., the correct essay format.
- Provide an accurate word count between brackets at the end of your essay.

Content – a mark out of 15 for relevant content for each of the paragraph topics provided.	15 marks
