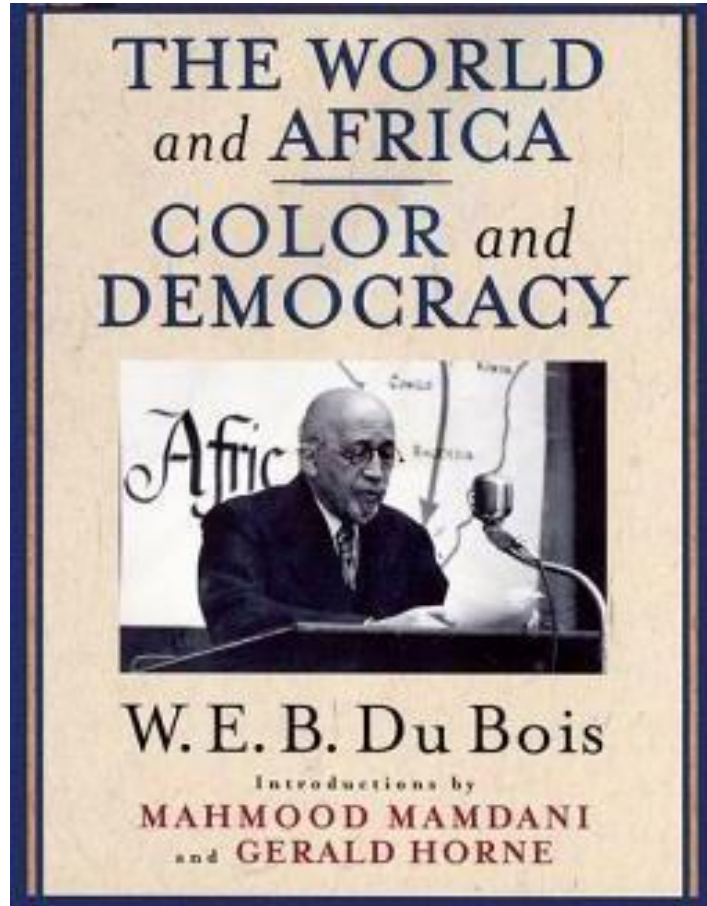
Examine the impact of Fidel Castro on the Cuban Missile Crisis by answering the following questions:
